2 County Resolutions

ORDINANCE 360 YES NO

- Changes term limitation for future County Commissioners from 2 four-year terms to 3 four-year terms, (does not change two-term limit for current Commissioners)
- Creates County Charter offices of Sheriff, Trustee, Register, Clerk, and Assessor. Assigns currently effective duties to these offices.
- Establishes a limit of three four-year terms for Sheriff, Trustee, Register, Clerk, and Assessor, and Term-limits future Mayor to same. (Current Mayor term limit unchanged)
- Abolishes salary petition for Trustee, Register, Clerk, and Assessor and gives a limited right for arbitration of salaries to Sheriff.

ORDINANCE 361 YES NO

- Institutes a citizen-initiated Recall provision for all county officers
- Authorizes Multi-Year budgeting for all county offices
- Forbids County elected officials from holding another compensated elective office
- Provides for vacancy in Mayor's office and succession of authority following a disaster
